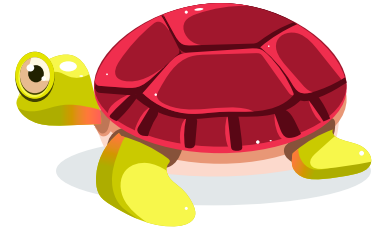


LAND AND WATER

What's it all about?

Children discuss and compare differences between land and marine animals feeding processes and habitats. They then identify and discuss the differences in life cycles between marine life and land creatures, and how they have adapted to live in their environments.



Children then learn and discuss environmental changes and dangers to their habitats and learn what they can do in order to help preserve these habitats.

This session includes class discussion, animal demonstration sessions and a question and answer session.
